The SIA supports and services focused on mental & behavioral health and wellness and improving academic success for historically underserved focal groups. Services offered by SOESD were in district identified priority areas.



INTEGRATED PLANS & COORDINATION

Facilitated virtual community engagement; provided writing, feedback and revision support for SIA progress reports and annual report based on ODE's requirements, feedback, and questions.

DATA ANALYSIS

Analysis of qualitative data from engagement sessions; Co-created surveys and conducted qualitative and quantitative data analysis on responses.

MENTAL & BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SUPPORT

Create draft district Suicide Prevention, Intervention, and Postvention plans; provided suicide prevention and other professional learning and training on plans; attended regional meetings with community organizations to gather Information to share with districts; drafted Comprehensive Counseling Plans; provided technical assistance on mental and behavioral health topics.

PROFESSIONAL LEARNING

Identified district/charter school prioritized professional learning topics; organized virtual/inperson offerings on a variety of topics; developed asynchronous courses based on district/charter school identified needs.

COMMUNICABLE DISEASE MANAGEMENT SUPPORT

Monitored ongoing guidance and requirements related to contagious diseases; assisted schools and districts with plans and communication; support collaboration across districts and Local Public Health Authorities.
