Effective July 1, 2025, Certified and Registered Family Child Care will be operating from new rule sets. Each Family Child Care program should have received a printed copy of the new rule book in the mail. If you have not received your rule book yet, please reach out to your Licensing Specialist so they can provide you with one. DELC is creating an informational video series that provides an overview of the new rules, explains key features, and highlights major changes. The videos will be 5-15 minutes in length, so they can be watched individually when it is most convenient for you and your staff. There will be notification when this series goes live!
